

Newspaper Book Report

This book report will resemble the front page of a newspaper. Use the following guidelines.

TITLE/NAME OF NEWSPAPER

Create a title for your newspaper that is related to your book.

DATE

Under the Title/Name of Newspaper put a date on your newspaper that reflects the time period of the setting of your book.

ARTICLES

➤ Summary

In the first column, write a summary of your book, in a well-developed paragraph. Make sure your summary answers the 5 W's (Who? What? When? Where? Why?) and the headline relates to your summary.

➤ Main Character

Write a brief article about the main character. Describe who the character is, what he or she did, personality traits, and interesting things about the character. Create a headline that relates to the article, and either draw a picture or use clip art to portray your main character.

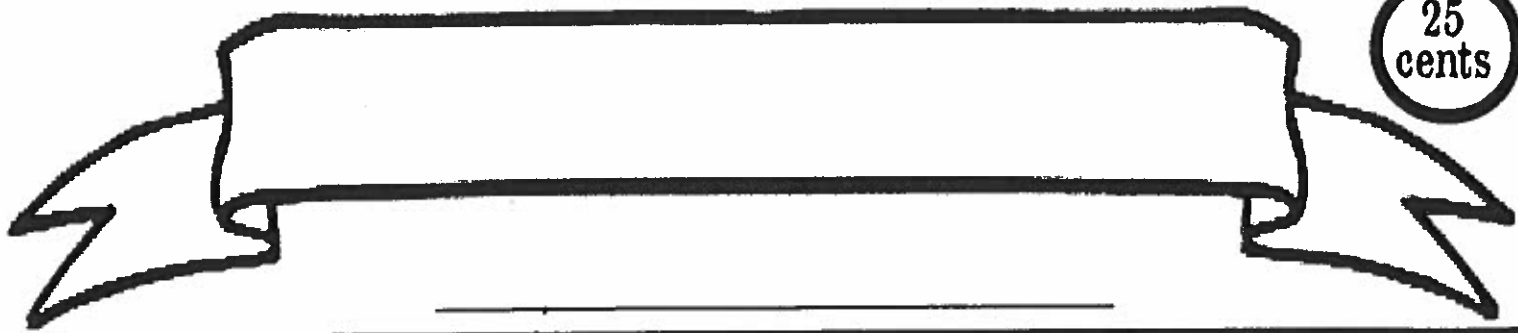
➤ Book Review

Write a review for the book you read. Explain what you liked and disliked about the book. Would you recommend this book? Don't forget to create a headline for your book review.

ADVERTISEMENTS, CROSSWORDS, AND MORE

All the space in your newspaper should be filled. After you have written all that is required, be creative to fill up the remaining spaces. Suggested possibilities include want ads, advertisements, crossword puzzles, word searches, riddles, or obituaries. Make sure everything relates to the story you read.
